#### ***Promotion of Project Results and Achievements***

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On the 27<sup>th</sup> of September 2022, participants from Goce Delcev University – Stip, as partner organization in the project ***Mathematics of the Future: Understanding and Application of Mathematics with the Help of Technology*** have organized an event which aim was promotion of the project's results and achievements. On the event there were invited and participated more than 10 foreign and 20 local participants. The most of the participants were math teachers, but there were also engineers and other researchers as interested parties in the project's results. The venue of the event was Metropol Lake Resort in Ohrid, Republic of North Macedonia.

The event started with registration of the participants. There were participants from foreign countries: Bulgaria, Bosna and Herzegovina, Serbia and Kosovo, and also local participants from many towns in North Macedonia.

After the registration, participants from Goce Delcev University started with the promotion of the project results and achievements. At the beginning, Prof. Biljana Zlatanovska has introduced participants with the project, its priorities, goals and target groups, emphasizing that almost all of the goals are reached. After her talk, short break followed.

Next, Prof. Marija Miteva talked about project results and achievements. She has explained in detail what was done in each intellectual output, describing the work separately in IO1, IO2, IO3, IO4 and IO5. She has introduced to the participants the project web site <https://futuremath.pmf.uns.ac.rs/> where they can find all project's outcomes, published results and other activities done in the frame of the project. She has also shown project results published on the web site. She has noticed that the last intellectual output is not finished yet and all the results are still not published on the web site, but it will be finished in a few days and during the October will be available to use. The coffee break followed.

In the last talk, Prof. Limonka Koceva Lazarova has introduced to the participants the new teaching method developed in the frame of the project, and that is the FutureMath method, based on the real life problems, actually emphasizing problem-based and project

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based learning. She has notice to the participants that various teaching material like lesson plans, real life problem situations, examples for using digital resources and other technologies, tests for checking students' knowledge etc. are developed in the frame of the project and are available to the interesting parties via the project web site. After her talk, the lunch break followed.

In the second part of the event, there was discussion with the participants about project results and further development. The moderator was Prof. Marija Miteva. The participants gave their view point of the related things, some teachers explained their experience and different methodology in the process of teaching mathematics, asked questions about details of our experience in the process of implementation of the new method in the classes etc. Participants have exchanged one to each other e-mail addresses and phone numbers for further cooperation.
